Many of the students at **DCC** also went "all in" with their finances by giving over **\$10,000** to help fund the **100,000** meals that they packed by hand at the conference!



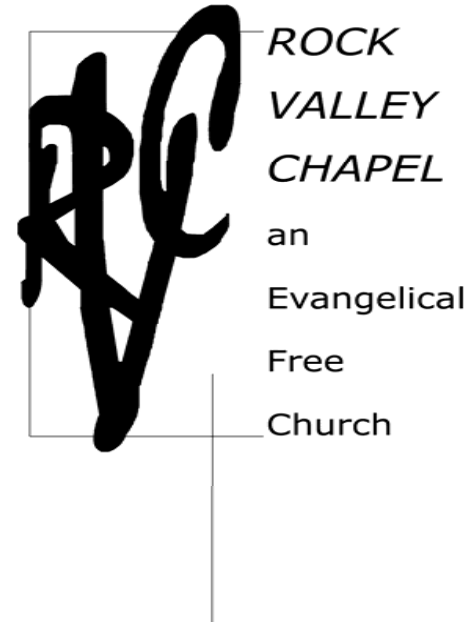
The meals will be sent to Haiti to help relieve some of the suffering there and show Christ's love in a tangible way to people who desperately need it.
